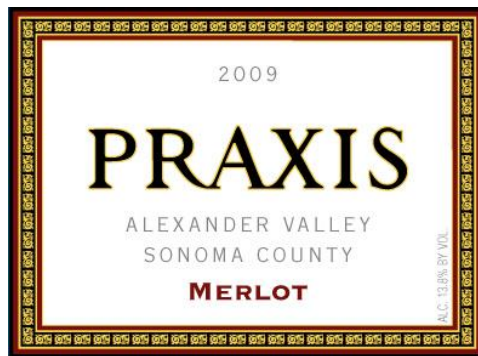


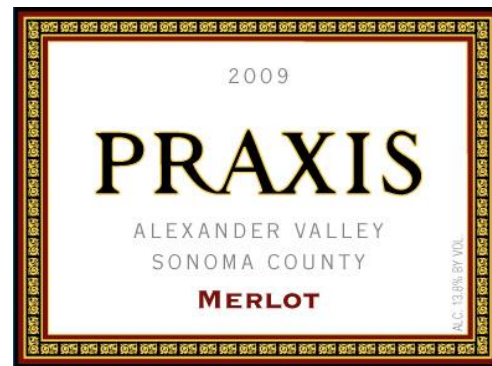
Gold Medal – 2012 Orange County Fair

- Juicy, plush wine has a long finish with medium tannins & toasty oak



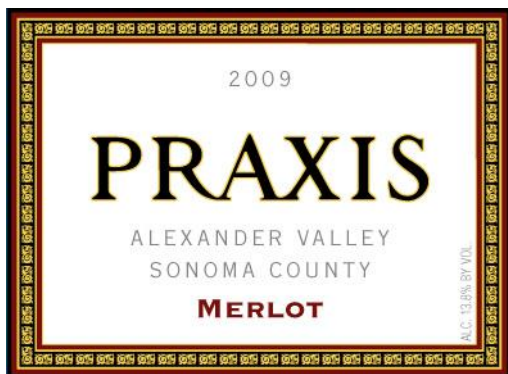
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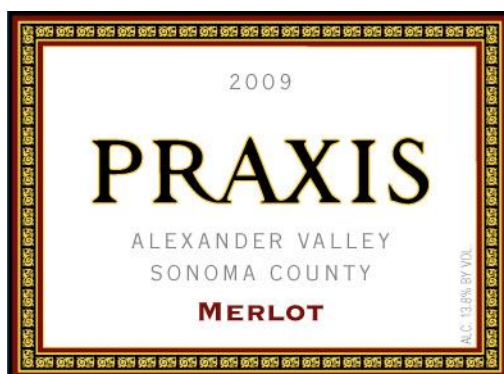
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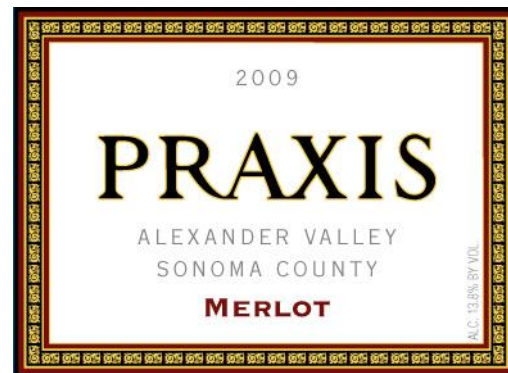
Gold Medal – 2012 Orange County Fair
